

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Limestone Township Board**  
**Township Hall--N3010 Highway M-67**  
**June 25, 2025      7:00 pm**

The Regular Meeting of the township board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Thomas Curry at 7 p.m. Present at roll call: Supervisor Thomas Curry, Treasurer Brian Menghini, Trustee William Brisson, Trustee Ingrid Hoy, and Clerk Danita Rask. Absent: none. Guests: Assessor Mark Maki, Alex Kolton-Director of Alger Conservation District, Steve Baker and Brian Hoy-Mathias Township Fire Chief.

The Pledge of Allegiance was taken.

There was no Public Comment.

A motion was made by Trustee Brisson to adopt the consent agenda. Motion carried. The Minutes of the Regular Meeting on May 20, 2025, were accepted. The Treasurer's report was accepted and placed on file. Checks #12937– 12947 were written to pay the monthly bills.

A motion was made by Trustee Brisson to accept the agenda with the addition of 'cemetery completion & headstone'; 'water leak at Hall' and 'signatory for Northern Lights Accounts' under New Business. Motion carried.

There were no Meetings Reports.

The Assessor's report was received from Mark Maki.

Correspondence was noted and filed.

There was no Old Business.

In New Business Alex Kolton of the Alger Conservation District gave updates on future waste tire collection grants that will be available in 2026. Limestone and Mathias Townships are being considered for them.

In reference to a letter received regarding the closure of the Limestone Townships dumps, it was noted that the dump on 26<sup>th</sup> Road was closed in 1978.

The cemetery brushing is now complete, and Trustee Brisson noted a missing headstone. Steve Baker has agreed to make a new stone marker for this site.

Trustee Brisson stated that a leak in the plumbing had occurred at the hall when the water was turned on for the season. He will contact a repair person to fix this.

The signatories for the Northern Lights Community Credit Union accounts will need to be updated to include the Deputy Treasurer and Deputy Clerk's signatures. As passed at the regular meeting on November 20, 2024 the following has been agreed upon—

“In New Business a motion was made by Clerk Rask to have the following people authorized as signatories on township bank accounts and be able to conduct financial business for the township effective immediately and that Rosalee Taskey's name and address be removed from all accounts as outgoing Treasurer also effective immediately.

Authorized people are: (newly elected) Treasurer Brian Menghini; Deputy Treasurer Andrew Henseler; Clerk Danita Rask; Deputy Clerk Kenneth Johnson and Supervisor Thomas Curry. In a roll call vote: Curry=yes; Brisson=yes; Rask=yes; Taskey=yes; Hoy-absent. Motion carried.”

It was decided to remove Thomas Curry as an authorized signatory for these accounts. In a roll call vote: Brisson=yes, Rask=yes, Hoy=yes, Menghini=yes and Curry abstained. Motion carried. Treasurer Menghini will get new signature cards completed.

There were no Board Concerns.

In Public Comment Fire Chief Brian Hoy updated the Board about fire department activities.

A motion to adjourn was made by Clerk Rask at 8:12 pm. Motion carried.
