

**Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Limestone Township Board**

**March 26, 2025      7:00 pm**

The Regular Meeting of the township board was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Thomas Curry. Present at roll call: Supervisor Thomas Curry, Clerk Danita Rask, Treasurer Brian Menghini, and Trustee William Brisson. Absent: Trustee Ingrid Hoy. Guests: Steve Baker and Assessor Mark Maki.

In Public Comment Steve Baker had questions about the minimum lot size in the township.

The Treasurer's report was accepted and placed on file. Checks #12891-12903 were drawn to pay the regular monthly bills. Checks # 12904-12907 to Hannula Agency, Mathias Township Fire Department, Gleaner, and Municipal Retirement Systems were also signed and will be held until April 1<sup>st</sup> payment due date.

In Meetings Reports, Supervisor Curry and Assessor Mark Maki reported on the recent meetings of the Board of Review.

The Assessor's report was received and noted by Mark Maki.

Correspondence was noted and filed.

In Old Business David Savola protested his taxes for a lower rate. He was told to contact State Representative Jack Bergman or the Alger Road Commission as his taxes were already lowered and money to fix the bridge was used elsewhere. Assessor Mark Maki has contacted him.

In New Business, the current budget and new proposed budget were discussed. The Budget Hearing is set for Saturday, March 29<sup>th</sup>.
